

## **Cowley Student ID & Username**

Your Student ID and Username will be assigned via email after submitting application.

Your Cowley Username will be your last name, the first letter of your first name, and the last four of your Cowley ID Number.

(If your last name includes a hyphen or apostrophe that will be removed from your username.)

Example: Tank Tiger, ID 1203456 -your username will be: TigerT3456

(Password setup link sent via "Your New Cowley Connect Account Info" email)

## **Using Computers on Campus or Access to Wireless Network**

Students have access to computers on all Cowley Campuses. Students may use their personal computers to access the wireless network from various "hot spots" on the Cowley campuses. To do so, students will log in using their student usernames and given password.

## Check your Student Portals through the Single Sign On

**Cowley Connect** is your all access student portal. Here you can view your schedule, financial aid, billing, contact your advisor, etc.

**Cowley Email - Office 365** is one of the primary methods of communication with college personnel. It is vital to check it often! Office 365 also gives you access to Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc. for **FREE**.

**Blackboard Ultra** This is your learning management system (LMS) that you access on the Internet. It is where your online courses are housed. Not taking an online or hybrid course? Instructors also use Blackboard for posting materials online to a complete virtual learning environment.

- Your courses will **NOT** be visible on your Blackboard account until the start date of that course and you have completed the **Ultra Blackboard Orientation**. *Please complete assignments the first week*.
- The Blackboard Orientation is created to allow you to test drive an online course before taking your real classes! **Goal:** This unfacilitated and self-paced course will quickly increase your comfort level with online learning and provide practice with common course tasks. This course will remain available to you throughout your time at Cowley, so that you can always go back and review or access the materials.
- If you have questions regarding the course content, please reach out to your instructor via the message center of the course shell, or Cowley College email. If you have questions of a more technical matter, visit Assist from your Blackboard homepage for additional services such as our 24/7 Blackboard help desk, Academic and Disability Support Services, and even free tutoring through the Tiger Learning Center.

#### How do I find out which textbooks I will need and how much my course materials will cost?

- Textbooks are required for most Cowley College courses. Log into your Cowley Connect account. Once logged into your Cowley Connect account, simply select My Cowley Textbooks under the Student Tab on the left side. Your personalized course material list will automatically populate for you based on courses that you are currently enrolled in. (Winter sessions books please use the Bookstore website)
- Course material requirements, including price, are available on the Bookstore
  website <a href="www.cowleycollegebooks.com">www.cowleycollegebooks.com</a>. Click Shop Textbooks to select Buy or Rent. You will select the term,
  department, course number and section of the courses that you are currently enrolled in from your class
  schedule.

#### What do I need to bring with me when purchasing course materials at the Cowley Bookstore?

Please bring your **Cowley Student ID Card** and a **PRINTED** copy of your course schedule.

#### Can I order my textbooks online and pick them up when I arrive on campus?

Yes, you sure can! The Cowley Bookstore offers **FREE** in-store pickup at the Ark City Campus Bookstore. After your online order is submitted, allow 1-2 business days for processing. You will receive an email when your order has been processed and is ready for pickup.

#### Can I order my textbooks online and have them delivered to a Cowley outreach location?

For a \$4.95 delivery fee, your order can be delivered to a Cowley campus location nearest you! Allow 1-3 business days for processing and delivery. Processing times may vary due to availability of inventory, especially during peak times of the semester. A Cowley representative will contact you when your order has been delivered and is ready for pickup hours of 8:00am-4:30 pm M-F. Spring and fall. Summer hours M-Th.

## **FAFSA Checklist**

Apply Online: Studentaid.gov For Help: 800-433-3243

To apply for federal student aid, such as federal Pell grants, Loan funds, and Work-Study, you will need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year.

On the 2025–26 FAFSA form, every contributor (you, your spouse, a biological or adoptive parent, or your parent's spouse) who's required to provide information on the FAFSA form needs a StudentAid.gov account before accessing and completing their section of the online form. Create it now at <a href="https://www.studentaid.gov">www.studentaid.gov</a> and select Create Account. Then please wait **3 days** to proceed.

To start the online 2025–26 FAFSA form, select **Log in** to Start New Form under the correct one that you want to complete to enter your account username and password. After logging in, you'll be given the option to select your applicable role to fill out the FAFSA form: "Student" or "Parent." You (the student) should select "Student." If a parent wants to start their dependent child's FAFSA form, they should select the "Parent" option.

## Gathering the Documents Needed To Apply for the 2025-26 FAFSA® Form

You may need the following information or documents as you fill out the 2025–26 FAFSA form:

- Your parents' SSNs if you're a dependent student
- Tax returns
- Records of child support received
- Current balances of cash, savings, and checking accounts
- Net worth of investments, businesses, and farm

Schools you list on the application will automatically receive your FAFSA results electronically <u>Note</u>: Schools will not be able to see which other schools you listed on your FAFSA form

## **REFUND POLICY**

Students should refer to their Cowley Connect / schedule to determine the last day to drop a class(es) and be eligible to receive a refund. If within the refund date, you can drop a class via your Cowley Connect account or by completing a drop-withdraw form. (\*Late enrollment does not extend the refund period). If it is past the refund date and students would like to withdraw from the course, submit a drop-withdraw form to the Admissions office or to your advisor. If the institution cancels a class, the student will receive a full refund regardless of the date. \*\* Failure to attend classes and/or telephone calls do NOT constitute a drop and does NOT entitle the student a refund.

Each student receiving and accepting goods and services (classes, housing, bookstore, etc.) from Cowley College will be responsible for paying for such goods and services by immediate payment, and/or deferred installment payment plan. If the Student defaults on such payment obligation, Cowley College reserves the rights to engage a collection service agency to collect outstanding debt and any other default payments owed to the college. The collection agency fees may be up to the State of Kansas maximum of 15% of unpaid debt after default, and the student will be responsible for paying the outstanding debt/default payments, and the collection fees assessed on such debts/default payments.









## Installing Microsoft Office applications on your personal device


Log in to your Cowley College email account, click on the 9 dots in the upper left corner, then click on the "Microsoft 365" icon



In the next window, click on the "Install and more" drop-down menu and chose "Install Microsoft 365 apps"
