

FIRST CLASS BASICS

ENROLLMENT

Classes and trips are on a first-come, first-serve basis, and spots cannot be held. If you are unable to attend either enrollment event, you may enroll anytime beginning Monday, August 18, by contacting Micah via phone or email.

CREDITS

If you have earned credit via the refund policy or a canceled class, please be sure to use your credit this semester. A full list of credits is available at checkout.

REFUND POLICIES

CLASSES: Refunds are not given if you are unable to attend class. However, you may transfer to another class if space is available.

TRIPS: Refunds for trips are not guaranteed. They are given only for family emergency, illness, or death in the family. A substitute in your place is greatly appreciated if possible.

administer and refund credits are subject to an administrative fee and unreturnable supply costs.

Credits will be held for 5 years and then considered a donation to the program.

FEES

Fees for classes and trips are paid at the time of enrollment. There is a one-time \$5 semester registration fee, and each class's price is listed in this catalog with the course description. The listed price includes any additional costs or supplies needed.

DAY TRIPS

Trip 1: Come From Away Musical Thursday, September 18th in Salina, KS


Theatre Salina presents a regional production of *Come from Away* a heart squeezing musical put on at the Kephart Theatre. *Come from Away* is based on the true story of the time when the isolated community of Gander, Newfoundland, played host to the world. What started as an average day in a small town turned into an international sleepover when 38 planes, carrying thousands of people from around the globe, were diverted to Gander's airstrip on September 11, 2001. Undaunted by culture clashes and language



barriers, the people of Gander cheered the stranded travelers with music, an open bar, and the recognition that we're all a part of a global family. This show explores themes of human connection, resilience, and the power of community. This trip, including dinner before the show, will cost \$60 and has a tentative time frame of 3:00pm to midnight.

Trip 2: Police and Prohibition Wednesday, October 8th in Ellinwood, KS

A repeat from Spring 2025: To kick off this day trip, we are headed back in time to the Wild West and the prohibition era! In Ellinwood, KS., we will visit the 1894 Historic Wolf Hotel and get a glimpse of life along the Santa Fe Trail during prohibition times. While the rich history of the hotel is fascinating enough, the real intrigue lies below the surface. It's lower level is connected to an underground tunnel system that runs throughout Ellinwood. Once home to a variety of storefront, these tunnels now house a fully functioning prohibition



era speakeasy bar that operates on Fridays and Saturdays. Together, we'll tour the tunnels and travel back in time. Please note, the tunnels on this tour are accessible only by stairs, and the tunnels may find us on slightly uneven ground. There will be places to sit and rest throughout the tour though. After our adventures, we'll head back to modern times at the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center. We'll learn about the training center, tour their classrooms, and we might see if we can peak into an active training scenario! We'll leave at approximately 7:30am and return to Cowley College around 6:30pm. Lunch is included, and the cost of the trip is \$45.

Enrollment Essentials

Tickets will be available starting at 12pm at Ark City's event and at 10am at Wellington's event. You do not need to arrive this early, but please do not congregate earlier than this. 
Trip 3: Svensk Hyllningsfest Friday, October 17th in Lindsborg, KS

Occurring in October of odd numbered years, the residents of Lindsborg, KS host a community-wide festival and don traditional Swedish folk costumes to celebrate the Swedish pioneers who settled the Smoky Valley in 1868 – 1869. The festival features art and crafts, special foods, ethnic music, and other special entertainment while Swedish folk dancers and musicians add to the flavor of the festival. After we had so much fun two years ago, we are headed back to attend day one of the festival again! There will be many exhibitions to explore, but our day will culminate with one of the best-loved events: the Swedish Smörgåsbord. We will savor the Smörgåsbord, a Scandinavian feast. Most of the food is prepared from recipes handed down from the early Swedish settlers of the Smoky Valley area, but some is imported from Swedish vendors. All with the goal of an authentic Swedish Smörgåsbord that closely resembles those of yesteryear. This trip will leave at approximately 10:00am and return to Cowley College around 9:15pm. Dinner is included, and the cost is \$45.

Trip 4: Mystery Trip

Thursday, November 13th / Location Unknown (to you)

It is a top secret trip. Sign up, hop on the bus, and be surprised. This semester's hints: we are headed north to Wichita and, unlike several of our past November trips, this one won't center around holiday fun. If you are up for an adventure, like surprises, and are flexible, this is the trip for you. The only rule: you get what you get, and you don't throw a fit. We'll leave at approximately 7:30am and return to Cowley College around 6:30pm. Lunch is included, and the cost of the trip is \$55.
